Az Civics Test

In 2015, the Arizona legislature passed the American Civics Act (House Bill 2064) requiring the graduating class of 2017, and all after to pass a civics test based on the United States Immigration and Naturalization civics questions. Students will be required to score 60% or higher in order to graduate from high school. Students have their first shot at taking the test in the 8th grade. This test will occur in late February or early March.
